Naming School Uniform

Medicine in School

Just a reminder that medicine should not be sent into school in book bags. If your child needs medicine in school, please put the medicine in a separate bag and hand it to a member of staff. If your child is at Kids Club, please hand it to a member of Kids Club staff who will pass it

to the class teacher.

If your child needs medicine during school hours, please make sure that you have also completed the Administration of Medicine form as we are unable to administer any medicine without this authorisation. Medicine must be prescribed by the doctor and must have the prescription details on the bottle or packaging and be clearly marked with your child's name.

The NHS Flu Immunisation team are coming into school next Tuesday 19 September to give flu vaccinations to the children across all year groups.
