SCHOOL UPDATES



MY CHILD AT SCHOOL APP TO REPLACE PARENTMAIL

After Easter, we will be using a new messaging and online payments system called My Child At School (MCAS). This new system will replace our current ParentMail PMX system.

This week we have sent out a parentmail message with information on how to download and set up the app. You should also have received an invitation email with the following information:

- School ID
- Your username
- Invitation code

This information will need to be entered to enable you to set up your MCAS account.

We would be grateful if all parents could do this as soon as possible and by Friday 31 March at the latest.

If you are having any problems with any of the above, please contact the school office and we will be happy to help.

In order to ensure that all balances can be correctly transferred from ParentMail to MCAS, we will be stopping online payments in Parentmail from Friday 31 March. There will be a migration period where balances will be moved across from Parent Mail to MCAS and during this time we will not be able to accept any online payments. We will then hope to go live with the new online payment system shortly after Easter.

Please bear with us through this transition period - there may be a few issues that need to be ironed out but we will keep you updated.
