#### **Operation Encompass**

Broomley First School is an Operations Encompass school. Operation Encompass is a police and education early information safeguarding partnership which enables schools to offer immediate support to children experiencing domestic abuse.

Children are negatively impacted by experiencing domestic abuse and without early intervention and support this negative impact can last through a child's life. Domestic abuse can impact upon social, psychological, physical, emotional and behavioural outcomes with an often negative impact upon a child's academic success. Experiencing domestic abuse has been identified as an Adverse Childhood Experience.

Operation Encompass aims, by directly connecting police and schools, to better understand the impact living with domestic abuse has upon children, to enable schools to better understand a child's lived experience and to therefore be able to support and nurture each child making a child's day better and giving them a brighter tomorrow.
