

Start of Day Procedures after Half Term

When we return after half term, we are introducing some new procedures for the start of the day. We would like you to bring your children onto the

yard in the morning to line up. The current system makes it very difficult for classes to have a prompt start to the day as children are arriving at different times. This will also give you the opportunity to speak with staff and pass on any urgent messages directly to the class teacher.

Registration takes place between 8:50 am and 8:55 am. Our first lesson begins promptly at 8:55am. Class teachers will head into school as soon as the majority of their class is in the line. This will be by 8:45am. We will open the side gate at 8:35am and it will close at 8:50 am so children can be ready to start their day on time. If you arrive late and the gate is closed, you need to take your child to the main door and sign them in using the iPad sign in system.

To find the Father's Day lunch Payment option on MCAS, please look under 'Product' in the menu down the left hand side of the MCAS screen. There should be an item that says 'Father's Day Lunch'. If you click on this to open it and then hover over the image, it will allow you to add the payment to your basket.

Everyone should have received a google form to complete which allows dads (or uncles and grandads) to choose their lunch option depending on which day they would like to attend. If you haven't received the form, please let the school office know.
