

Parent Support / Liaison Role:

Most of you will probably already know Mrs Swan as our wonderful Senior Learning Support Assistant in school. This year however, in addition to her current role, Mrs Swan will be undertaking a role of parent contact support.. She now has specific time in her week to work with school families with a range of services. This role will involve Mrs Swan supporting families with attendance, lateness, uniform queries and homework. As part of this role, Mrs Swan will also be running parent and child

ops and developing community links too.

We are really excited to have Mrs Swan supporting in this way, and think her role will complement and enhance the work that already goes on within school.

If you wish to contact Mrs Swan she will be on the yard at home time every Tuesday and Wednesday or alternatively you can message the office or speak to your child's class teacher to get in touch with her.



Parent and Child Craft and chat sessions:

As mentioned above, we will be running some parent and child craft and chat sessions in school from the week beginning 14th November. These sessions will be per year group and will be on a Tuesday afternoon between 2.20 and 3.10pm. The first session will be on Tuesday 15th November and will be for parents and carers of Y4 children.

School Arrivals and Pick up

As I'm sure you spotted, the remaining scaffolding and containers were finally removed from the school throughout the October Half term. This now means we are able to look at the best and safest options for arrival and pick up everyday. From Monday 7th November the following will apply for each year group:

Reception: Arrival and dismissal remaining the same as current arrangements

Year 1: Arrival through the gate next to the cricket field (therefore no longer the main entrance)

Dismissal from the year 1 classroom door (veranda)

Year 2: Arrival through the gate next to the cricket field (therefore no longer the main entrance)

Dismissal from year 2 classroom door (veranda)

Year 3: Arrival through the gate next to the cricket field

Dismissal from door left of the veranda.

Year 4: Arrival through the gate next to the cricket field.

Dismissal from yard door.
